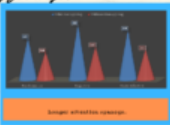
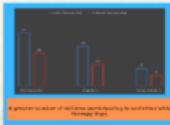


- To create a new Intervention Protocol in Ecosystemic Canine-Assisted Play Therapy with Survivors of Interpersonal Trauma.
